It takes a long time to feel at home after emigrating

I was a little confused when I left my home in Ireland, my country, and arrived in Canada, on the other side of the world. It takes time to connect with your new place, your new country, but one day you will say, “I love my country, but this is home”.

After three years alone in a small rural town in Ontario, Montreal was love at first sight, but it wasn't home. Only my home town could be home, as only my Mum could be Mum.

Then, after thirty years, on a warm, sunny day in April 2009, after cycling a bike path around a canal, I sat on a seat by the shore, ate my sandwiches and an orange, drank from my water bottle and then relaxed and admired the sun shining on the waves and thinking about nothing in particular.

After about 15 minutes, I felt well, different. It took me some time to recognise that I was at peace. Then, surprisingly, I couldn't find my home town anywhere in my thoughts: from that moment on, I felt at home in Montreal.

I needed to understand what had made me think differently. I realised the reason for my transformation was the closure, at the end of January 2009, of the little software company where I had worked for 18 months. Near my 60th birthday and with the job market in trouble, I knew my career was finished. This change of circumstances didn't traumatise me; instead, I felt free, freer than I had since I immigrated.
